We are appointed as governors by the LEAD Trust and have oversight of the school. We do this by visits to the school, meeting staff and pupils, attending social events and through formal governing body meetings. We also attend courses to learn how to be an effective governor.

Some personal reflections on why being a governor at Birley Spa Primary Academy is so worthwhile:





As a community governor I have recently supported in school during the Easter Fayre and previous Christmas Fayres, which are generally well attended by the parents and carers. In previous years I have supported on KS1 and KS2 trips. I have also been involved in staff recruitment.

In my role as SEND governor I attend SEND meetings every term to discuss progress and issues around SEND provision. I have recently been in school during the Y6 SATs and was very impressed by the resilience of the Y6 pupils and their determination to do their very best in the tests. I was also impressed by their embrace and practice of yoga techniques they had learned in school in order to be calm and ready for their tests or indeed when facing any stressful situation.

As governors we are invited to Engagement Meetings in school each term; these are very interesting and informative as we often meet pupils from different year groups to discuss their learning. At a recent meeting we were treated to a talk (presentation) by KS2 pupils, about an area of the Science curriculum, in order for them to explain their understanding of how new learning builds on their previous learning from KS1. The pupils were very articulate and confident in their explanation to governors. They were a credit to the school.
