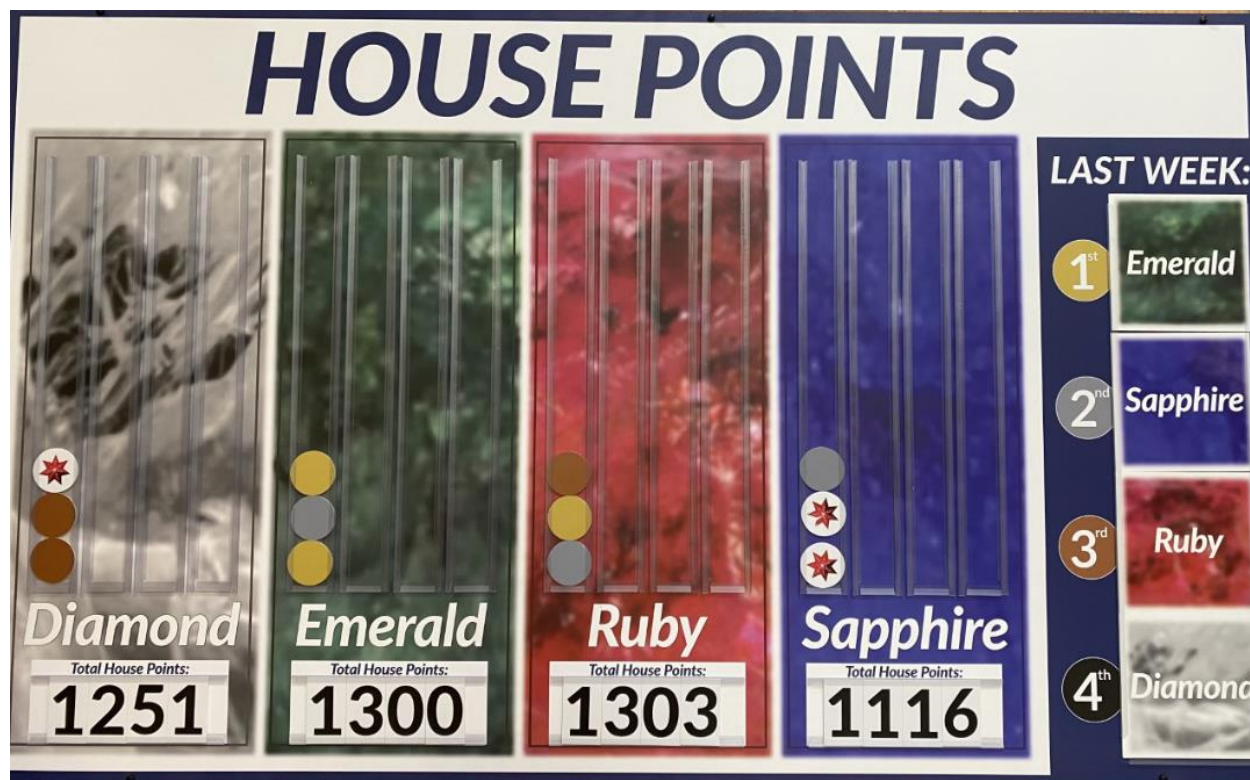


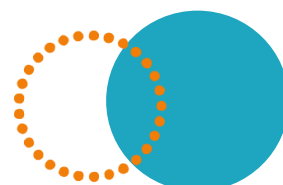

Our children have been amazing gaining so many house points – Well Done to Ruby team who are slightly ahead so far!

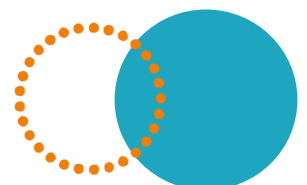
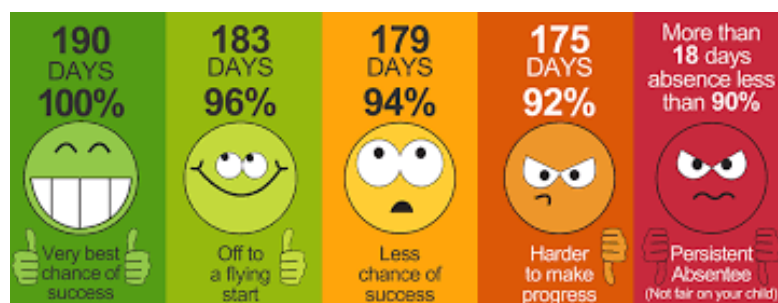
