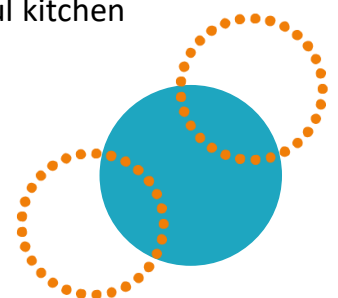

Friday	Fish fingers & chips or Cheese Pastry

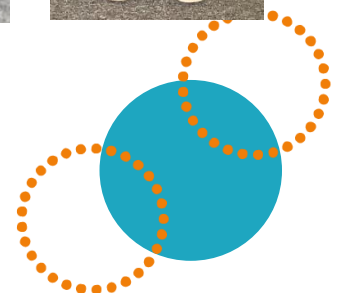
Jacket potato's and sandwiches will be available everyday.

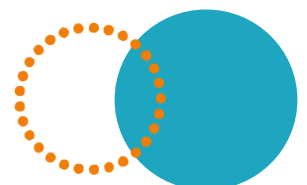
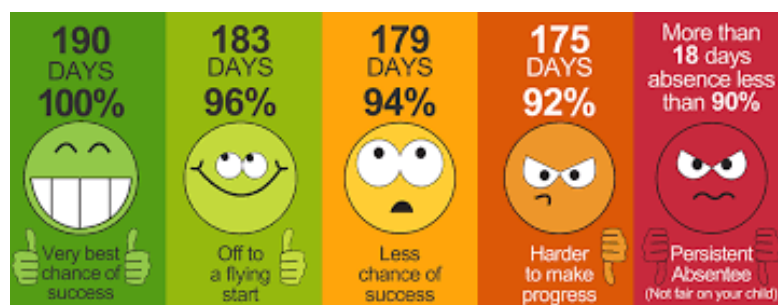
