

School Uniform and Personal Belongings Policy

Trousers (smart)

Skirt or Pinafore Dress

Cardigan

All of the above items plus:

Dress Red checked

Shorts (tailored) Black

P.E. Kit

Indoor: Plain white t-shirt and black shorts or black jogging bottoms/leggings (no football kits)

Outdoor: Plain white t-shirt and black shorts or PE Skirt with black plimsolls/trainers.

In Winter, a plain black track suit or would be useful.

On PE days, children should come in their PE kits for the full day.

Parents are asked to mark all their child's clothing and other belongings with their name.

Hair

Long hair on girls and boys should be tied back for PE. Hair must be of natural colour.

Earrings

For safety reasons, we encourage children not to wear earrings for school. Newly pierced ears must be covered with plasters before participation in sport sessions. These plasters must be supplied from home. If earrings are worn, we permit 1 pair of small studs only.

Personal Belongings

No other jewellery, apart from a watch, may be worn in school. Children/parents will be asked to remove any earrings/jewellery as soon as they are noticed. Whilst every effort will be taken to ensure the safety of the children's personal property, neither the school, nor L.E.A.D. Academy Trust can take responsibility for any loss or damage. Therefore, children should not bring valuable personal items into school.

If a child in Year 5/6 walks home independently, they may bring their mobile phone for safety reasons. This must be handed in to the teacher immediately upon arrival and will be stored in the office until the end of the school day. Children have no access to their phones during school time.
