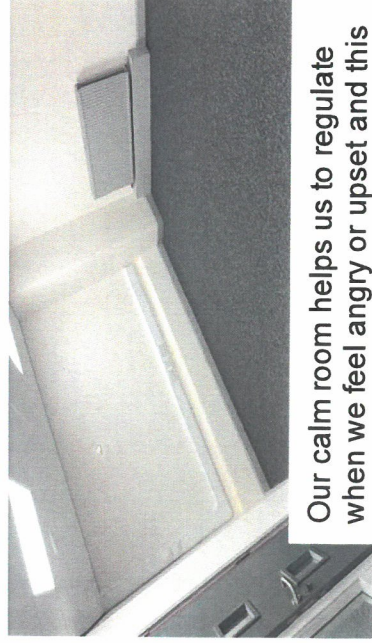




The Communication Room

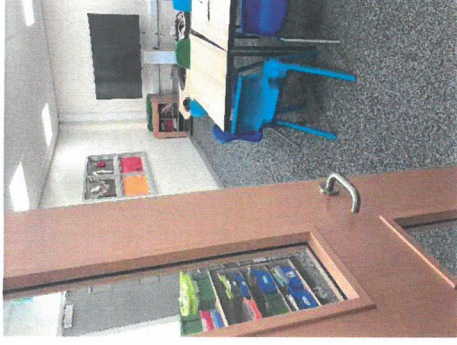

Integrated Resource ESPA

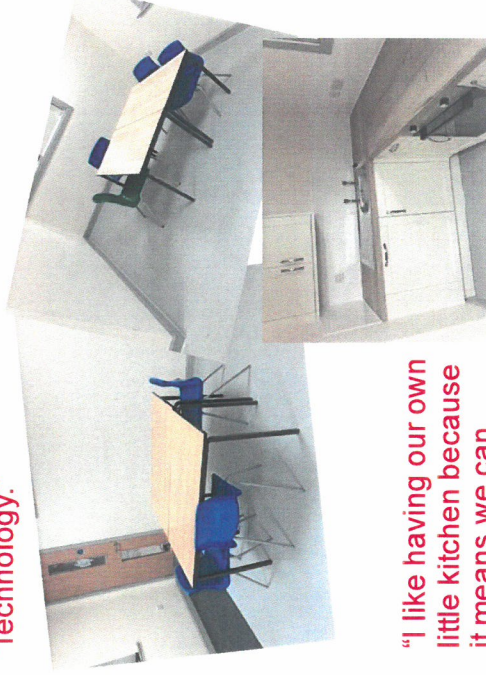
